

MCAS MIRAMAR Military Sport Bike Rider Course Enrollment

To all,

For someone to enroll in an MSRC at Miramar they would do the following:

1. Bring their motorcycle to the safety office (blg 9442).
2. Provide military ID, DL with MC endorsement, current Insurance and proof of prior training e.g.) BRC or ERC card. If they are missing one of afore mentioned documents, they must be able to present them the day of class.
3. Fill out an inspection sheet.
4. Have their motorcycle inspected.
5. If the motorcycle is safe for training they write their name down in the enrollment binder for their desired class date.
6. They are given a copy of the inspection sheet which includes the day, time and location of their class.
7. If their bike has deficiencies e.g.) a bald tire or sticky throttle, they can still have a slot for class but they must have those deficiencies corrected by the class date.
8. Trainer bikes are available for unique circumstances and will be determined on a case-by-case basis. Some examples would include:
 - *The student's only bike is a track bike and not street legal e.g.) with non-street tires.
 - *The student was recently in an incident and the bike is in for extensive repairs.

PLEASE NOTE: Base DOD employees have different inspections standards for allowing a student to enroll in any class. According to DOD employees, all bikes must meet CVC codes prior to enrolling in any class as base policy.
